Parking and Road Safety at St. Matthew's National School

We have two wonderful School Wardens at St. Matthew's National School. Please continue to use these services as much as possible, following the rules of the road, so that this vital service remains in place.

Always remember to cross the road with the School Warden when you are told it is safe to do so.

It is not permitted to stop or park in the yellow box or 'zig-zag zone' at the bottom of the school laneway. Please do not stop, park or pull into this area when bringing your children to or collecting from school. This is a matter of safety for our children attending the school who cannot see or be seen by traffic.

For many years we have enjoyed harmonious relations with our neighbours, please do not park in a manner that blocks neighbour access to/from their driveways.
