### Library



As you may be aware the Library has been relocated to the corridors this year, to facilitate an additional classroom!

Due to this change the Library will now operate a little differently. All children will have an opportunity to visit the Library fortnightly on a Monday. Every child will take out ONE book each. 6<sup>th</sup> Class and Pre-School will have their own Library with a selection of books which will be managed by their respective teachers upstairs. The other children will choose a book from the downstairs corridors with the Librarians. For simplicity, Library day will be on the same day for every class. It is important that the book is brought back on Library day. Unfortunately, children that don't return their book will not be allowed to borrow any more books until that book is returned.

The Library service is a very valuable resource for the benefit of all the children. Therefore we would ask all parents to be mindful of this and look after and ensure the return of all books on their due day so that the service can continue to run efficiently.

We look forward to seeing the children on our first Library day which will be on Monday 12<sup>th</sup> November. As always, if anyone is available on Mondays and eager to join our committee, please let the school office know!
